

AVALON TENNIS RULES

1. At least one member per court must check-in at the Pro Shop and register if they are playing with a guest. Guest fees are \$5 per guest and are to be paid at time of check-in. Individual guests limited to 20 visits per year. **Members are responsible for making sure this fee is paid.**
2. Members can sign up for court time by visiting <http://reservemycourt.com/index.htm>. Court reservations will be for an hour and a half (90 minutes). Members arriving later than 10 minutes of their scheduled court time may forfeit use of the court when others are waiting.
3. Members should wear appropriate tennis attire and tennis footwear is required on all courts. **No black soles**, flip-flops, crocs or sandals allowed on the court. During the summer months, swim shorts are permissible and girls should wear a skirt or shorts over bathing suit. Shirts are to be worn by members and guests at all times.
4. Courts may be used for teaching only by employees of Avalon only, unless otherwise approved by the Director of Tennis.
5. Avalon leagues, team matches and tournaments (including make-up or rescheduled matches) will always have priority over reservations. The Tennis Pro will make every effort to post team practice and match schedules. **Social matches may not occur next to league, team or tournament matches.** The Tennis Pro has the right to change court assignments to maximize play availability and court usage. No backboard play while matches are taking place.
6. Only members and their guests playing tennis are allowed on the courts.
7. Bicycles or skates of any kind (including, but not limited to, skateboards, rollerblades, scooters, Heelys, etc) are not allowed on the tennis courts. Violators will be charged for damages and repairs of courts and/or Club equipment.
8. Foul language is not permitted on the tennis courts. Failure to exercise good sportsmanship and proper tennis etiquette may result in a player forfeiting a point, game, match or the player may be asked to leave the court.
9. Lights turn off automatically at 9:50pm every night. The last players to leave the courts are responsible for turning off the lights and locking the courts to prevent vandalism.

Please note that the tennis key unlocks the bathroom at the tennis shop. Please lock after each use (during the off-season). The tennis key also unlocks the property-entrance front gate.
